## Jesus Revealed in Me

### Galatians 1: 14-17

Paul saw a truth that few of us have seen. It is that God's ultimate purpose in saving us is "...to reveal His Son in me..." By means of His Lordship, Christ wants to make us so like Him, that Jesus is revealed to the world through us.

### Question: Is Jesus being revealed in you?

**Note:** To reveal Jesus **to** you is not the same as revealing Jesus "**in**" you.

Paul sees that salvation is a process whereby we are "His workmanship" and we are to, "work out your salvation with fear and trembling"

In **Philippians 2:12,13** "*Work out*"= to accomplish, or complete a task. Thus finish what God started in you!

The word for "work" is only used of God's activity in Scripture, never man's work.

"Fear & trembling"= not fear of His wrath or judgment, but fear of disappointing Him.

### 1. Your Part= work it out

God is doing the work, we can only answer "yes" this is good; or "no" this is bad. Our part is to be submissive to His rightful lordship, with a "yes" in our spirit.

### 2. His Part= work it in. See Eph. 2:10

God is the craftsman who began a good work in you and He is determined to finish what He began!

### 3. What is God trying to accomplish in you? What is His "good pleasure?"

Evidence of Christ's continued Lordship in us is the part He is "working out" & "working in" right this minute.

See **Col. 1:19**= His will (pleasure) is the fullness of Christ in each of His sons!

See **Romans 8:29**= we are "Predestined to become "conformed" to the image of His Son."

See **Gal 1:15, & 2:20**

**Conclusion:** Everything God is doing in your life is to Reveal Christ in you, till you are "full" of Him.

**Question:** Do you focus on the events of your life, or what God is revealing to you thru the events??

A mark of maturity is when you are so consumed with His Revelation of Himself to you and in you that you **blinded** to other events and see only Jesus working out His good pleasure in you.
